

Good Morning everyone.

- Was CAVA given its mission from the archdiocese, or was CAVA started at the initiative of the religious and sanctioned by the archdiocese?
 - My reason for this question is that there seems to be some disparity in the understanding of CAVA's purpose. Is our primary purpose to promote religious vocations in the archdiocese, or to support vocation directors in the archdiocese?
 - o I understand the need to reframe the mission and vision statements, but I don't think it is your intention to change the mission.
- Do we want to use all the input from the members to craft new mission and vision statements, or do we need to correct the understanding of CAVA's purpose?

- What/Who (Who makes up CAVA, whom do we serve or help, with whom do we serve?)
- Where Chicago and beyond

Articulate Vision Statement from the Hopes section

- 3. Email our initial review/response to the responses
- 4. Do Conference Call to share, discuss, distill and perhaps come up with distilled mission statement and vision statement or at least towards some recommendations.
