National Catholic Sisters Project Funding – Important information!

As a member of CAVA you may qualify for some funding for an event you wish to implement as part of the National Catholic Sisters Project (NCSP). Please send your proposal to Sr. Lovina at Lpammit@archchicago.org. The event or initiative may include promotion of your own congregation or in collaboration with other communities to encourage young women to consider becoming a Sister. Chicago's Got Sisters, Online Discernment and Pizza with Volunteers are examples of collaborative programs that CAVA implements. These are already being supported by NCSP. Although the NCSP grant is targeted for promotion of Sisters, funding of these events indirectly benefits men's communities as well so I encourage you to work collaboratively to include the men when you craft your initiative. Be creative!
