- · 1 (#2 size) can, pineapple chunks, drained

Directions:

Beat eggs until light in color adding sugar gradually, then lemon juice. Add butter, milk, salt, and pineapple. Stir in bread cubes. Pour into greased 13" x 9" pyrex baking dish. Bake at 325 degrees for 30 to 40 minutes. Great with turkey or ham too!
